



2024 MEMBERS MONTHLY TOURNAMENT (MMT)

Friday, April 26, 2024
Player and Palmer courses

I. GENERAL MMT GUIDELINES:

- Open to **amateur golfers** only.
- The **maximum** handicap index allowed for any player is **40.0**.
- A player or team may only win one (1) award, whichever is higher.
- Members **must adhere to the Club's dress code**, which strictly **prohibits** wearing **any slippers** in the Clubhouse, especially during awarding. Open-toed sandals are permitted for ladies, but slippers are not allowed. Non-compliance may result in a request for members to change their footwear. This guideline aims to maintain a consistent and respectful atmosphere in line with the Club's standards, golf traditions, and country club etiquette.
- The guidelines mentioned above may change as necessary.

II. ELIGIBILITY:

- Open to all members, spouses, and enrolled junior dependents in good standing.
- Dependent children (unenrolled), 12 years and above, shall be waitlisted and accepted if members do not fill the slots by **Tuesday, April 23**.

III. REGISTRATION:

- SMS registration opens on the following days from **6:00 AM to 12:00MN**:
 - **Monday, April 8** - for Player Course
 - **Tuesday, April 9** - for Palmer Course
- To register via SMS, text **joinmmt** and send to **0917-888-2345** or **0918-888-5432**. Only those enrolled in the SMS tee time booking system may register using said platform.
- Further registration and/or cancellation shall be made through the Golf Office beginning **Wednesday, April 10**.
- Only a maximum of 120 players shall be accommodated per course. Those who exceed the limit shall be on a waitlist and notified should there be available slot/s.
- A Player who gets slots on both courses should decide on/or **before Saturday, April 13 at 5:00 PM** on his preferred course. Otherwise, they will be assigned to the Player as the default course.
- Only **120 players** shall be accommodated per course, **95 for Men** and **25 for Ladies**. Those who exceed the limit shall be on a waitlist and notified should there be available slot/s.
- **Unfilled slots** on both Men and Ladies by April 14 at 5:00 PM shall be open to waitlisted players or new registrants.

IV. ENTRY FEE/RAFFLE:

- **P1,000.00** per player, inclusive of food and raffle
- Entry fees may be settled on the tournament day through the player's folio.
- Only players who participated in the tournament will be included in the raffle.
- Presence is **required** for the special and major raffles.
- Presence is **not required** for the previous month's feedback and cash raffles.



V. LATE CANCELLATION PENALTY:

- The following cancellation penalties per Player shall apply:
 - > **No penalty** – for cancellations made **on/or before Friday, April 19**
 - > **P500.00** – for cancellations made **from April 20 to 23, 5:00 PM**
 - > **P1,000.00** – for cancellations made **beyond 5:00 PM on April 23**

VI. USE OF GOLF CART

- Use of a golf cart is mandatory on a twin-sharing basis
- Players who wish to have solo carts will be accommodated on a first-come, first-served basis and should inform the golf office on or before **April 23, Tuesday**.
- Players who are willing to share a cart but end up solo shall have to pay half of the applicable cart rental fee only if the reason is due to the following: other player didn't show up or used a private cart
- Players with a private golf cart, may still be assigned a club-owned golf cart, upon request.

VII. FORMAT:

- 18- Hole Individual Stroke Play Competition (Net & Gross Strokeplay)
- Event title: Low Gross and Low Net Championship

VIII. COURSE/TEE TIME:

- Player - 6:30 AM Shotgun start
- Palmer - 6:45 AM Shotgun start

IX. HANDICAP INDEX & HANDICAP:

- Handicap index – The player's average WHS handicap index as of **December 16, 2023** and current handicap index as of **April 1, 2024** shall be the player's handicap index.
- Tournament Handicap – shall be based on the Player's tournament handicap index, converted to course handicap on the set of tee the Player is playing.

X. CLASSIFICATION

- Classification shall be based on the players' handicap indexes
 - > Class A- first lowest 25%
 - > Class B- 2nd 25%
 - > Class C- following 25%
 - > Class D- last 25%
 - > Ladies- two (2) groups (Class A&B) if more than 20 participants; Otherwise, one group only as Ladies Division

XI. STARTING TEES

- Ladies - Red Tees
- Men's Class A & B - Blue Tees
- Men's Class C & D - Silver Tees

XII. SPECIAL TOURNAMENT RULES TO SPEED UP PLAY:

- The maximum score in any hole is nine (9), including penalties.
- **"Gimme" Putt** – Any ball **lying within or above the line** of the 24-inch gimme circle shall be considered holed on the Player's next stroke. The Player must pick up his ball and add one stroke to his last stroke's score.



XIII. AWARDS

Winners shall be on a **per course basis**

- Class Low Gross Champion
- Class Champions & Runners-up (Net)

Note: Should a player qualifies for the Gross and Net Award, they should win the Low Gross Award.

XIV. TIES:

- Ties shall be settled through the Player's score:
 - a) last 9-holes totals (10-18);
 - b) last 6-holes (13-18);
 - c) last 3-holes (16-18);
 - d) countback starting the 18th hole, then finally; by
 - e) toss coin

Note: Gross score for Low Gross and net score for Champions and Runners-up.

XV. RULES OF GOLF:

Play shall be governed by the latest Rules of Golf published by R&A Rules Limited and the Club's Local Rules.

XVI. Committee:

The Committee reserves the right to make any changes in the TOC, if it deems fit and necessary. Disputes if any, shall be settled by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final.
