We are pleased to inform you that **blinkers have now been installed on all our marshals carts** as part of our **continuing efforts to improve on-course communication and smooth pace of play**. These blinkers will **minimize physical interaction** between **marshals and golfers** while communicating a warning of slow pace of play, or indicating that the next hole is open with delays at the back.

- **YELLOW BLINKER** will indicate that a **flight is lagging behind the group ahead and creating an open hole**. Even if the flight is still within the allowable pace of play, marshals will activate the yellow blinker when they observe an open hole ahead.
- **RED BLINKER** will be used to signal that a **flight is not only out of position but is also exceeding the standard pace of play that causes delays**. Once a red blinker is activated, **the flight is expected to catch up with the flight in front within 30 minutes**. Should the group fail to do so, **marshals are authorized to pause the flight and allow the faster groups to play through**.

We kindly ask all golfers to be **mindful of their pace of play**, avoid creating **unnecessary gaps ahead**, and ensure they **do not cause a buildup of groups behind them**. Maintaining consistent pace is essential to keep the game moving efficiently and enjoyable experience for all golfers. Groups that observed to be **causing delays and buildup behind them** will be **recorded for slow play** and **reported to the Golf Office** and/or **if necessary, to the House Committee**.
