

# 27<sup>th</sup> FOUNDERS CUP REMINDERS

## I. FORMAT

- **Palmer Course** – 18-hole Net Aggregate Stroke Play competition; combined points of partners count as the team's score.
- **Player Course** – 18-hole Net Four-Ball Stroke Play competition; Better net score for the hole counts as the team's score.

## II. SCORING FORMAT

- 36-hole Stableford scoring system with handicaps
- Stableford points will count as follows:  
 Net Double Bogey – 0 point, Net Bogey – 1 point, Net Par – 2 points, Net Birdie – 3 points,  
 Net Eagle – 4 points, Net Double Eagle – 5 points, Hole-in-One – 6 points  
 Note: Record only your individual gross score on your scorecard or write an "X" mark in case of pick-up.

## III. TEE-OFF TIME

- Morning shotgun is 6:15AM
- Afternoon shotgun is 12:15PM

## IV. STARTING TEE

MEN (below 55 years old by Nov. 20, 2025)	MEN (55 years old and above by Nov. 20, 2025)	MEN (70 years old and above by Nov. 20, 2025)	LADIES (regardless of age)
<b>Blue Tees</b>	<b>Silver Tees</b>	<b>White Tees</b>	<b>Red Tees</b>

- Men, aged 55 years and above may opt to play from the Blue Tees, provided that this is declared on or before November 15, 2025.
- Men, aged 70 years and above may opt to play from the Silver or Blue Tee, provided this is declared on or before November 15, 2025.
- Men with tournament handicap index of 25.1 and above must tee off from the Silver Tees.

## V. MULLIGAN

- Mandatory for all participants.
- P600 for two mulligans per 18 hole round (charge to individual folio).
- May be used anywhere except on the putting green.
- Not valid for Hole-in-One prize.
- Must be announced to the marker before it is used.
- Outside the teeing area, mulligan ball must be dropped and played in the same area of the course within one club length from the spot of the original ball.
- Mulligan must be used once put in play.

## VI. HOLE-IN-ONE

- Prizes will be up for grabs on all par 3 holes.
- On Par 3 holes, participant has the option to tee off from their regular teeing area, or from the designated teeing area with a special hole-in-one prize.  
 (Note: After tee shot, a player may play his/her mulligan shot from the regular tee box but cannot win any Hole in-One prize. Hole-in-One from mulligan shot will be valid for scoring.)
- As a general rule, prizes for the hole-in-one shall be equally divided among the winners. Please refer to the Conditions of the Hole-in-One Prizes for more details.
- All hole-in-one prizes will be subject to winning tax.
