



20th STA. LUCIA GOLF TOUR - VIETNAM



TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. GENERAL TOURNAMENT DESCRIPTION AND GUIDELINES

- A 36-hole, Individual and Inter-Club golf tournament conducted by Sta. Lucia Realty and Development Inc.
- The competition shall be governed by the latest Rules of Golf as published by the R&A Rules Limited, this Terms of Competition and the host Club's Local Rules as provided.

2. PLAYING DATES & VENUES

- April 24, 2026 – Friday - 12:30PM Shotgun Start
Ba Na Hills Golf Club, Da Nang City, Vietnam
- April 25, 2026 – Saturday - 12:30PM Shotgun Start
Legend Danang Golf Resort- Nicklaus Course, Da Nang City, Vietnam

Note: The host Clubs will allow shotgun start if we meet the 120 minimum number of players, otherwise sequential tee off only.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- Open to dues paying members or dependents in good standing of any of the eleven (11) participating Sta. Lucia Golf Clubs.
- Participants must be at least 21 years old
- Guest participants will be allowed at certain Clubs as approved by the Committee

4. REGISTRATION

- Registration is on a per Club basis and closes on March 31, 2026.
- Limited to the first 132 registrants on a first-paid, first-served basis
- Every participating Club will be allotted with at least ten (10) slots until Feb. 20, 2026.
- Unfilled slots of each Club after the deadline will be offered to other Clubs
- Remaining slots in excess of the 10 slots per Club will be accepted on a first-paid first-served basis



- The tournament entry fee (please refer to “**Tournament Fee & Inclusions**”), individual Certificate of Voluntary Compliance, Medical Waiver and the individual’s entry form must be settled and submitted to the Club’s golf office on or before the deadline.

5. TOURNAMENT FEE & INCLUSIONS

- Tournament fee is **P41,940.00** per player, excluding airfare
- Inclusions are:
 - 5 days/4 nights stay at DLG Hotel, a five-star hotel located in Da Nang City
 - Two (2) rounds of golf with golf cart on a twin sharing basis and caddie fee
 - Airport to Hotel shuttle service for registrants who are arriving on April 22nd only
 - Hotel to Golf Club shuttle services during the tournament proper
 - Welcome dinner on the 22nd and dinner during the awards night on the 24th
 - Hotel to Da Nang Airport shuttle services on the 26th
 - K&G shirts for the awarding and other giveaways
- **Tournament fee is non-refundable but transferrable to another member of the same Club until April 15, 2026 only.**

6. FORMAT & COMPETITION

- **Individual Competition** – 36-hole, Stroke Play competition using Molave Points. The aggregate Molave Points for the two rounds is the player’s score or points.
- **Team Competition** – 36-hole, best 5 players per Club competition. The aggregate Molave Points of the top 5 scorers per Club for the two rounds is the Club’s Team’s points.
- **Club Competition** – will be based on points from the winning Club members. Point system for the Club from its Individual winners will be as follows:
 - Over-all Champion – 5 points, Low Gross Champion – 5 points
 - Class Champion - 3 pts, 1st Runner-up- 2 pts, 2nd Runner-up – 1 pt

Point system for the Club from its Team winners:

Team Champion- 8 pts, Team 1st Runner-up – 4 pts, Team 2nd Runner-up – 2 pts

The Club that accumulates the most number of points will be declared as the **SLGT Golf Club Champion of the year.**



7. HANDICAP & HANDICAP INDEX

- **Tournament Handicap Index**- is the player's lowest NGAP-WHS handicap index from Feb. 1 to April 1, 2026.
- The Club should submit the players handicap indexes of the said months on a bi-monthly handicap revision dates such as Feb 1, Feb 16, Mar 1 Mar 16 and Apr 1, 2026.
- Players with less than 20 games recorded as of April 1, 2026 shall have a handicap index adjustment as follows:
 - 16 to 19 games – 5% reduction
 - 11 to 15 games – 10% reduction
 - 10 games or less – 20% reduction
- Maximum handicap of a player is 36 after adjustment if there is any
- **Tournament Handicap** - is the player's Course Handicap based on Ba Na Hills Course's course and slope ratings.
- Players with out NGAP-WHS handicap index but have other handicap record may be accepted subject for adjustment as approved by the Committee.

8. STARTING TEES

- Men -White Tees
- Ladies – Red Tees

9. SCORING

- Modified Stableford Point System (Molave Point) with applied full handicap.
- Only gross strokes should be reflected on the scorecards. The Committee shall compute the player's Molave Points.
- Players on the flight must observed cross-scoring.
- Strongly recommended for the players to do the scoring and not their caddies.
- It is a player's responsibility to submit his/her scorecard within fifteen (15) minutes of holing out, otherwise the player's score will not count for that round.
- Any and all alteration in scores/on scorecards must be cleared and clarified before submission.
- Scores not legibly written will be subject to interpretation and/or adjustment solely at the committee's discretion.
- **Maximum points of a player per round is pegged at 60 points only.**

Net Eagle	5
Net Birdie	4
Net Par	3
Net Bogey	2
Net Double Bogey	1
Net Triple Bogey or pick-up	0

10. CLASSIFICATION /GROUPINGS

▪ **Individual Competition**

- Regular Division- Men participants below 55-year-old will be divided into four (4) groups as follows:
 Class A – Players with 10.0 and below Tournament Handicap Index
 Class B – 10.1 to 18.0
 Class C – 18.1 to 25.0
 Class D – 25.0 and above
- Senior Division – Men aged 55 and above. (Has the option to play in the Regular Division)
- Super Senior Division- Men aged 70 and above. (Has the option to play in the Regular or Senior Division)
- Ladies' Division – We'll have 2 groups base on handicap index if more than 15 lady participants, otherwise one division only.
- Sponsors Division – sponsors or individuals considered by the Committee

Note: Player's age will be based on his/her age as of April 24, 2026.

11. AWARDS & PRIZES

- Individual Competition (Class A, B, C, D, Seniors, Super Seniors, Ladies & Sponsors)
 - Over-all Champion – Player with greatest number of points based on net score
 - Low Gross Champion – Player with greatest number of points based on gross score
 - Class Champion
 - Class 1st Runner-up
 - Class 2nd Runner-up



- Team Competition (only for Clubs that has at least 5 players)
 - Team Champion
 - Team 1st Runner-up
 - Team 2nd Runner-up
- Club Competition
 - 2026 Sta. Lucia Golf Tour - Golf Club Champion of the Year

Awarding ceremonies with cocktails/buffet dinner and raffle of attractive prizes will be held at the DLG Hotel right after the second round.

12. TIES

In case of tie/s the following tie-break system shall be followed:

- Individual Competition – The player with the better Molave points on the second round shall prevail. If still tied, the last 9-holes (10-18 holes) points, then the last 6-holes (13-18), then last 3-holes (16-18). If still tied countback from the 18th hole. (Note: If the tied players exceeded their second round points from our cap of 60 points, the first tie break are their handicap. The lower handicap player shall prevail. If still tied, their last 9 holes points as stated above and so on.)
- Team Competition – The Team with the better points of their 6th player on the second round shall prevail. If still tied, the last 9-holes (10-18 holes) points, then the last 6-holes (13-18), then last 3-holes (16-18). If still tied countback from the 18th hole.
- Club Competition – The Club with the highest single award or points in the Team Competition shall prevail.

13. TEE-TIMES – There will be a shotgun start every playing day. The official pairings (sheet) will be posted at the lobby of the hotel on the Notice Board. Upon publication, hole assignments will be strictly enforced.

- **Rule 5.3** – Starting and Ending Round (R & A Rules Limited):

Time of starting – The player shall start at the time established by the committee.

Groups – During the round the competitor must remain in the group set by the Committee unless the Committee authorizes or ratifies a change. Penalty for breach of Rule 5.4b: Disqualification



If a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play within five minutes after his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two (2) strokes at the starting hole.

A participant may however, decide to join his/her assigned flight on the succeeding hole (considered as his/her starting point) and shall be deemed "pick-up" or zero point on his/her missed hole/s.

14. SUBSTITUTION - Substitution of players will be allowed until April 15, 2026 only

15. GIMME PUTT - In order to speed up play throughout the competition, all putts within 18 inches of the hole shall be considered "GIMME". Putters will be taped to indicate the 18-inch length or the greens will be marked correspondingly.

16. HOLE-IN-ONE PRIZE: In the event that there are 2 or more winners of the same prize, they will share the prize equally and be responsible for any and all taxes due.

17. FORMAL COMPLAINS/REQUEST

All Complaints/protest lodged by club teams/members and/or designated captains must be documented, coursed thru and signed by the authorized Club representative and submitted to the committee on the same day the dispute occurred.

18. THE COMMITTEE

The SLGT Committee reserves the right to amend, vary, modify or add to any of the tournament rules and conditions as the need arises. All decisions made by the committee are deemed final.

19. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- It is highly recommended that all participants avail of a Travel Insurance to avoid any inconvenience for any untoward incident.
- All participants are also strongly recommended to wear the 20th Sta. Lucia Golf Tour give-away shirt during the awarding ceremony in order to have a "uniform" look during this milestone event for the photo sessions.
