As temperatures continue to rise this season and dry weather conditions persist, all golfers are reminded to exercise heightened caution and proper judgment while on the course.

As the fairways continue to firm up due to the heat, golf balls are expected to carry farther, bounce higher, and roll considerably more than usual. Because of these playing conditions, shots may reach adjacent fairways, run into crossing areas, or travel beyond normal landing zones faster than anticipated.

Golfers are therefore strongly advised to be more mindful before playing each shot, particularly on holes with blind landing areas, nearby fairways, or areas with active player and caddie movement. Please ensure that the area ahead is clear prior to hitting and avoid taking aggressive shots when there is uncertainty as to player positioning or ball reach.

Golfers are likewise reminded to immediately shout "Fore!" whenever there is any possibility that a ball may endanger others, regardless of intended line or shot outcome.

While firmer conditions may be favorable for distance, they likewise require greater awareness and course discipline from all players to help prevent avoidable ball-hitting incidents.
