2-MAN TEAM MODIFIED SCRAMBLE

Saturday, August 22, 2026

Player and Palmer courses

I. GENERAL MEMBERS MONTHLY TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES:

- Open to **amateur golfers** only.
- The **maximum** handicap index allowed for any player is **40.0**.
- A player or team may only win one (1) award, whichever is higher.
- Members must adhere to the Club's dress code, which strictly prohibits wearing any slippers in the Clubhouse, especially during awarding. Open-toed sandals are permitted for ladies, but slippers are not allowed. Non-compliance may result in a request for members to change their footwear. This guideline aims to maintain a consistent and respectful atmosphere in line with the Club's standards, golf traditions, and country club etiquette.
- The guidelines mentioned above may change as necessary.

II. ELIGIBILITY:

- Open to all members, spouses, and enrolled junior dependents in good standing.
- Dependent children (unenrolled), 12 years and above, shall be waitlisted and accepted if members do not fill the slots by **Tuesday, August 18**.

III. REGISTRATION:

- SMS registration opens on the following days from **6:00 AM to 12:00MN**:
 - **Monday, August 3** - for Player Course
 - **Tuesday, August 4** - for Palmer Course
- To register via SMS, text **joinmmt** and send to **0917-888-2345** or **0918-888-5432**. Only those enrolled in the SMS tee time booking system may register using said platform.
- Further registration and/or cancellation shall be made through the Golf Office beginning **Wednesday, August 5**.
- Only a **maximum of 60 teams** shall be accommodated per course. Those who exceed the limit shall be on a waitlist and notified should there be available slot/s.
- Players who could secure a slot must register their partners on/or before **August 14, Friday**.
- Slots/teams with incomplete team members will be automatically canceled by **Saturday, August 15**, and slots will be given to the team/s on the waitlist.
- The team/s on the waitlist who will secure the canceled slot/s must complete its players within forty-eight (48) hours from the receipt of slot availability notification. Otherwise, the next team on the waitlist will be given the slot.

IV. ENTRY FEE/RAFFLE:

- **P1,000.00** per player, inclusive of food and raffle
- Entry fees may be settled on the tournament day through the player's folio.
- Only players who participated in the tournament will be included in the raffle.
- Presence is **required** for the special and major raffles.
- Presence is **not required** for the previous month's feedback and cash raffles.



V. LATE CANCELLATION PENALTY:

- The following cancellation penalties per player shall apply:
 - **No penalty** – for cancellations made **on/or before Friday, August 14**
 - **P500.00** – for cancellations made **from August 15 to 18, 5:00 PM**
 - **P1,000.00** – for cancellations made **beyond 5:00 PM on August 18**

VI. FORMAT: 2-Man Team Stoke Play Competition using a Modified Scramble Format

Mechanics of Play:

- Players of the 2-man team must tee-off alternately. Before starting the game, partners should decide who among of them partners shall tee-off on ODD -numbered holes (Holes 1,3,5,7,9,11,13,15 & 17) and the other partner on EVEN-numbered holes (Holes 2,4,6,8,10,12,14,16 & 18).
- After tee shot, the player who make the tee shot may mark and lift his ball. Both partners then shall play their second shot **by placing their balls within one scorecard length** from the marked tee shot not nearer the hole on the same condition. The scramble format shall then commence until they reach the green.
- The scramble format means partners shall select their best ball position on every shot and play their next shots from that same spot by placing their balls within one scorecard length from the marked or chosen ball on the same condition not nearer the hole, and so forth until players reaches the green. (Same condition means if the chosen ball is in the general area, both balls must be placed on the general area also, if it's in the bunker both balls shall be placed on the same bunker.)
- On the green, the players must choose whose ball will be used. **The player whose ball was not chosen must make the first putt.** The players will then putt alternately using the chosen ball until they hole out or until the ball lands on the "GIMME" circle.
- **On Par-3 holes:** Both players may tee-off, but only for the purpose of winning the Hole-in-One prize. The drive of the designated hitter on that hole will be the ball in play.

Note:

- *If the tee shot went OB, both players may hit their next shot from the tee, where the player's played playing 3.*
- *If the tee shot went into the penalty area, one of the partners should determine their relief area and must drop his ball in the relief area for a penalty relief. After dropping a ball to be in play, the player who dropped the ball has the option to play the ball as it lies or mark it first and lift it and then both partners may place their ball within one scorecard length from the marked position not nearer the hole to play their 3rd shot.*

VII. COURSE/TEE TIME:

- **Player** - Shotgun starts at **6:30 AM**
- **Palmer** - Shotgun starts at **6:45 AM**

VIII. HANDICAP INDEX & HANDICAP:

- Handicap index – The player's WHS handicap index from **August 1, 2026**, shall be used.
- Tournament Team Handicap – 20% of the course handicap of the higher handicap player plus 50% of course handicap of the lower handicap player

Sample Computation:

$$\begin{aligned} & \text{Player A: } 24 \text{ Hcp, } 20\% = 4.8 \text{ net} \\ + & \text{ Player B: } 10 \text{ Hcp, } 50\% = 5.0 \text{ net} \\ & \text{Team Handicap : } 4.8 + 5.0 = 9.8 \text{ or } 10 \text{ Hcp (rounded to the nearest whole number)} \end{aligned}$$



IX. CLASSIFICATION/ COURSE ASSIGNMENT

Classification shall be based on the Tournament Team Handicaps.

- ›Class A- first lowest 33%
- ›Class B - following 33%
- ›Class C- last 34%

X. STARTING TEES

- Ladies - Red Tees
- Men- Silver Tees
- Men participants 70 years old & above may opt to play from the White Tees

XI. SPECIAL TOURNAMENT RULES TO SPEED UP PLAY:

- The maximum score in any hole is nine (9), including penalties.
- **"Gimme" Putt** – Any ball **lying within or above the line** of the 24-inch gimme circle shall be considered holed on the player's next stroke. The player must pick up his ball and add one stroke to his last stroke's score.

XI. AWARDS

Winners shall be on a **per-course** basis

- Overall Low Gross Team Champion
- Group Team Champions
- Group Team Runners-up

XII. TIES:

- Ties shall be settled through the Team with the lowest net score of their:
 - a) last 9-holes totals (10-18);
 - b) last 6-holes (13-18);
 - c) last 3-holes (16-18);
 - d) countback starting the 18th hole, then finally; by
 - e) toss coin

Note: Gross score for Low Gross and net score for Champions and Runners-up.

XIII. RULES OF GOLF:

Play shall be governed by the latest Rules of Golf published by R&A Rules Limited and the Club's Local Rules. Questions shall be settled by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final.

XIV. COMMITTEE:

The Committee reserves the right to make any changes in the Terms of Competition (ToC), if it deems fit and necessary. Disputes if any, shall be settled by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final.
