Player Course

I. ELIGIBILITY

- Open to all members, spouses and dependents in good standing and with an established NGAP WHS handicap index as of August 1, 2026. Child must be paired with his/her parent or grandparent.
- Those without established NGAP WHS handicaps may still join and will be given a corresponding handicap by the committee.

II. REGISTRATION

- Opens from **August 8, Saturday at 8:00AM to August 23, Sunday.**
- Only **60 teams** will be accommodated.
- May be done via phone call at 0917-800-7273 / 0917- 884-6810 / (02) 8989-2000 locals 2241 and 42 or in-person at the Golf Office.
- Teams waitlisted during the May 2026 Parent & Child Tournament will be given priority slots.
- Registration will be accepted until **August 23, Sunday at 5:00PM.**

III. ENTRY FEE/RAFFLE/AWARDING

- P1,000.00 per player, inclusive of food and raffle entry.
- May be settled on the day of the tournament through the player's folio.
- Presence is required for the raffle draw.
- Only players who showed-up and play in the tournament will be included in the raffle
- Awarding will be held right after the game at the Grand Ballroom.

IV. CANCELLATION POLICY

- The following cancellation penalties per player shall apply:
 - › No penalty – for cancellations made on/or before August 25, Tuesday
 - › P500.00 – for cancellations made from August 26 to 28, Friday at 5:00 PM
 - › P1,000.00 – for cancellations made beyond 5:00 PM on August 28.

V. FORMAT

- 18-Hole 2-Person Team Scramble Stroke Play Competition (Full Scramble Format)
Possible team compositions: Parent and Child or Parent and Grandchild

Mechanics of Play:

Each player may hit their tee shot from their designated teeing area. Partners then select which ball or where to play for their next shot. Partners may mark, lift and clean the chosen ball. For the next shot outside the putting green, partners must place his/her ball within one (1) scorecard length from the chosen ball, no nearer the hole and on the same condition of the chosen ball. Same condition means if the chosen ball is in the "general area", the partner must place his ball also in the "general area". If the ball is on the bunker, it should be placed on the same bunker also, etc. If the chosen ball is on the putting green, partners may place his/her ball within one putter-head length from the chosen ball. This procedure shall be repeated until the ball is holed or is in the gimme circle.

VI. COURSE/TEE TIME

- Player Course – 12:00 NN Shotgun start

VII. HANDICAP INDEX & HANDICAP:

- Handicap index – The participant's NGAP WHS handicap index as of August 1, 2026, shall be used.



- Players' handicap shall be based on the slope and course ratings of Palmer Course.
- Maximum handicap of a player with established handicap index is 36.
- Maximum difference of partners handicaps should not exceed 15. Otherwise, the partner with higher handicap will be adjusted.
- Team handicap will be 35% of the low handicap player plus 15% of the high handicap player.
- Players without established NGAP WHS handicap index will be given a corresponding handicap (maximum of 26 hcp) by the committee.

VIII. CLASSIFICATION & COURSE

- Teams will be divided into four (4) divisions based on Team Handicap.
Division I – first 25% of the field with lowest team handicap
Division II – second 25%
Division III – third 25%
Division IV- last 25%

IX. STARTING TEES

- Men & Boys 12 yrs. old & above – Silver Tee
- Ladies & Girls 12 yrs. old & above – Red Tee
- Boys & Girls (8 to 11 yrs. old) – Orange Tee
- Boys & Girls (7 yrs. old & below) – Black Tee

X. AWARDS PER COURSE

Overall Low Gross Champion
Overall Low Net Champion
Division I – Champion and Runner-up
Division II – Champion and Runner-up
Division III - Champion and Runner-up
Division IV- Champion and Runner-up

XI. TIES

- Ties shall be settled based on the team's net scores:
 - a) last 9-hole totals (10 -18);
 - b) last 6-hole, (13 -18);
 - c) last 3-hole totals (16 -18);
 - d) countback from the 18th hole
- Ties for the Low Gross award shall be settled based gross score.

XII. SPECIAL TOURNAMENT RULE TO SPEED UP PLAY

- The maximum score in any hole is nine (9), including penalties.
- "Gimme" Putt – Any ball lying within or above the line of the 24-inch gimme circle shall be considered holed on the player's next stroke. The player must pick up his ball and add one stroke to his last stroke's score.

XIII. RULES OF GOLF:

- Play shall be governed by the latest Rules of Golf published by R&A Rules Limited and the Club's Local Rules.

XIV. COMMITTEE:

- The Committee reserves the right to make any changes in the Terms of Competition (ToC), if it deems fit and necessary. Disputes if any, shall be settled by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final.
